## PACKAGING AND LABELING REQUIREMENTS

Based on Adult Use Permanent Rules

MICHIGAN MARIJUANA REGULATORY AGENCY (MRA), ON AUGUST 2, 2021, ISSUED A 15 PAGE ADVISORY BULLETIN ON EDIBLES AND INFUSED PRODUCTS THAT SHOULD BE REVIEWED IN ADDITION TO THE REGULATORY RULES THAT FOLLOW.

#### GENERAL

- 1. Marihuana-infused products must be homogenous.
- 2. The allowable variation for weight and THC and CBD concentrations is + or 15%.
- 3. "Edibles" are broadly defined to include any product containing marihuana that is intended for human consumption in any manner other than smoke inhalation.
- 4. Maximum adult-use serving sizes: 10 mg THC per serving, and 100 mg THC per container for edibles, 200 mg per container for capsules and tinctures. No specified serving or container sizes for non-ingested products like topicals and lotions, etc.

#### PACKAGING

- 1. Edibles must be in opaque, child-resistant packaging
- 2. Multiple serving edibles must be CR resealable

#### LABELING:

**Marihuana products** must be labeled by the producer or packager with: 1. The name and address of the processor or packager

- 2. The name of the product.
- 3. An ingredients list in the FDA format
- 4. The net weight or net volume of the product

#### Edibles, in addition to the above, must:

- 1. If major allergens are present, include appropriate FDA format labeling
- 2. If nutritional claims are made, include appropriate labeling per federal guidelines
- 3. Include the statement "Made in a marihuana establishment" (min 11 pt & contrasting color)
- 4. Not be in a shape or labeled in a manner that would appeal to minors including no cartoons, caricatures, toys, or similar designs or shapes
- 5. Not be easily confused with commercial candy, or use the word candy or candies
- 6. Not be in the shape, caricature or likeness, real or fictional, of a human, animal, or fruit. Edibles that are geometric shapes and simply fruit flavored are compliant
- 7. Be shelf stable and not require time or temperature control
- 8. Include an expiration or use-by date.

# ADDITIONAL MARIHUANA PRODUCT PACKAGING AND LABELING REQUIREMENTS FOR RETAIL SALE:

- 1. The name and license number of the **producer**, including business or trade name, and state tag or source number
- 2. The name and license number, including business or trade name, of the **packager** if different from the processor
- 3. The unique identification number for the package or the harvest, if applicable. 4. Date of harvest, if applicable.
- 5. Name of strain, if applicable.
- 6. Net weight in United States customary and metric units.
- 7. Concentration of THC and CBD.
- 8. Activation time expressed in words or through a pictogram.
- 9. Name of the marihuana safety compliance facility that performed any test, any associated test batch number, and any test analysis date.
- 10. The following warnings:

"For use by individuals 21 years of age or older only. Keep out of reach of children."

"It is illegal to drive a motor vehicle while under the influence of marihuana."

"National Poison Control Center 1-800-222-1222."
